NIGERIAN COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION (NCC): PROFESSORIAL CHAIR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF IBADAN

A Nigerian Communications Commission's Professorial Chair has been endowed at the University of Ibadan, aimed at a local specialty research effort to foster a close relationship between the University and the Nigerian Communications Commission in the area of 5G network deployment in Nigeria. The specific areas of research will include allocation of bands, interference assessment, internet availability, and policy options for protecting and promoting competition in a digital economy.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the Nigerian Communications Commission's Endowed Professorial Chair in the University. Applicants must have been a Professor of the University of Ibadan for at least three (3) years and a distinguished scholar in any of the following disciplines: Communication Science, Telecommunications, Information and Communication Technology (ICT), with a multidisciplinary approach. The research programme and associated academic activities shall align with the University's record of excellence in the stated fields. Applicants shall, therefore, state in clear terms, the vision, mission, and logistics of the impact-oriented project.

The appointment which is to commence as soon as possible is for two (2) years in the first instance. The conditions and salary areas approved for enhanced Professional Chairs in the University. The occupant will be required to lead a Seminar each session and at the end of the tenure organise a major seminar /lecture.

Interested candidates should forward twenty-five (25) copies of their Curriculum Vitae, stating phone number, e-mail address(es), age, marital status, qualifications, and experience, (teaching, research, and publications).
