OPENING OF THE PORTAL FOR STUDENTS TO APPLY TO THE EMERGING YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR (EYE) AFRICA BUSINESS PLAN COMPETITION

METHOD OF APPLICATION

To qualify for the competition, applicants must:

- 1. Be full time students of University of Ibadan
- 2. Be certified to be 100, 200, or 300 level students at the time of application

The competition process includes programs that will equip participants with life changing Agribusiness knowledge and entrepreneurship skills, and give participants access to:

- A pool of mentors
- Financing
- Prototyping and Incubation Support
- Business networks
