3. HONOUR AND DISTINCTION

2017 HUMBOLDT ALUMNI AWARD FOR INNOVATIVE NETWORKING INITIATIVES: PROF. ADEREMI RAJI-OYELADE

Professor Aderemi Raji-Oyelade, a lecturer in the Department of English, Faculty of Arts has received 2017 Humboldt Alumni for Innovative Networking Initiatives. He is expected to build a cross-border research network throughout Sub-Saharan Africa that will be dedicated to the development and dissemination of proverbs and “postproverbials” in African languages. As part of the initiative, **PACE Network: Postproverbail Africa – Building a Corpus of Wits in Texts, Media and Performance**, proverbs and postproverbials of 13 local African languages will be collected in the course of interviews, focus group discussions and by the use of questionnaires. These proverbs and postproverbails, together with explanatory notes, will be made available to members of the network in a database and as part of a web application. A multilingual publication is planned as well.

The award given to Professor Raji-Oyelade is in recognition of the status of the University of Ibadan as Nigeria’s foremost university.
