The Exposé is an opportunity to showcase research and technological innovativeness at the University of Ibadan while establishing and/or strengthening scholarly links and fruitful collaborations within the University, Industry and Government.

EXHIBITION GUIDELINES FOR THE 2017 FAIR

Items That Could Be Exhibited: Physical materials/artefacts/machines/equipment, Books/audio & video materials, Photographs/posters

Movement of Materials to the Venue: This shall be the responsibility of the Faculties/Centres/Departments. Photographs of heavy machines and equipment that cannot be easily moved can be exhibited.

Provision of Exhibition Booths: A maximum of **three booths** shall be provided for each Faculty/Centre. Faculties/Centres that may require additional booths should notify the organizing committee well ahead of time for their request to be considered.

Manning of Exhibition Booths: It shall be the responsibility of the Faculties/Centres/Departments to make adequate arrangements for manning their respective booths. Provision will, however, be made for daily supply or refreshments for a maximum of six persons per Faculty/Centre for the duration of the exhibition. Security shall be provided overnight for exhibition items. However, Faculties/Centres/Departments are strongly advised not to leave 'handy items' in their booths overnight.

Entertainment of Guests: Faculties/Centres/Departments are advised to make their booths lively through provision of light music, playing of documentary videos of their activities, etc.

Display of Identification Posters: Faculties/Centres/Departments are advised to make colourful posters that would be mounted at the entrance of their booths for easy identification.

PLEASE NOTE THAT EXHIBITIONS WILL BE ASSESSED AND AWARD GIVEN.
