PROCESSING OF ADMISSION LETTERS

Management has noted the hardship being experienced by students who have not been issued admission letters by the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) and those who intend to reject offer of admission previously made to them by other institutions. Management has, therefore, resolved that the University would assist students to facilitate the process after paying the required amount prescribed by JAMB.

JAMB accepts the payment of \(\pma_3\),000.00 (Three Thousand Naira) only per student as processing fee for admission letter and the sum of \(\pma_1\),000.00 (One Thousand Naira) per student for rejecting initial offer of admission.

To this end, ALL students of the University who have not been issued admission letters by JAMB or intend to reject initial offer of admission are advised to report at the Admissions Office (Undergraduate) on or before 30 April, 2013 for further information.
